

Additional Orders

These new measures represent additional extraordinary and emergency measures contained within a new and additional Emergency Order, "Emergency Powers (Covid-19) (No.2) Order, 2020".





Work Remotely

Everyone must work remotely from home unless:

- Essential worker
- Business you work for is exempted from Order
- Where working remotely is not possible the business should stop operations





Public Service Workers

All must work **remotely** from home **unless specifically designated as an essential worker**.



Exceptions to Closure of Businesses

Wholesale or retail grocery stores and Farmers' Markets from 6 am to 7 pm – the first two shopping hours reserved for seniors, disabled persons and essential

Such other businesses or undertakings as may be specifically exempted in writing by the ***Competent Authority** – provided that the owner or operator of the establishment specified in (a) – (1) shall adhere to physical distancing protocols.

Physical Distancing

Requirements for businesses:

Customers and staff should maintain distance of no less than 6 ft inside and outside of business.

- Only 1 person per every 30 square ft of building space allowed in store
- Distance markers must be placed 6 ft apart for customers to stand in line inside and outside building.





Restrictions to Social Activities

- No private parties with anyone outside immediate household
- No recreational or competitive sporting events
- No weddings with more than 10 guests



No banquets, balls or receptions

★ No social events

- No Funerals with more than 10 members of immediate family
- No meetings of fraternal society, private or social club or civic association or organization



International Travel Restrictions

Except with written permission of the Competent Authority: all airports (including private airports and FBOs) are closed to incoming international flights carrying any visitor.

- All seaports closed: regional and international seafaring and private boating

- No visitors permitted to enter or disembark including transiting through The Bahamas

Does not apply to:

- Outgoing flights and ships
- Cargo flights or cargo ships
- Commercial courier flights
- Emergency medical flights
- Emergency flights approved by Civil Aviation Authority



Domestic Travel

Not permitted:

- Mailboat, sailing inter-island, except for transport of freight
- Inter-island private commercial sea transport
- Commercial travel

*Competent Authority may vary any requirement.

Exempted businesses



- The Bahamas Red Cross
- Arawak Port Development
- Freeport Container Port
- Freeport Harbour Company
- The Bridge Authority
- Cloud Carib Limited
- A business licensed to provide security guard services

- A Credit Union

- A commercial bakery
- Only construction companies carrying on hurricane relief reconstruction and restoration efforts in the islands of Grand Bahama, Abaco and their respective cays



Exempted Workers



- The Royal Bahamas Defence Force
- Fire Services
- The Department of Correctional Services
- The National Insurance Board
- The Department of Social Services
- The Department of Environmental Health Services

- The Customs Department
- Waste disposal and sanitation companies
- Hospital, health care or medical facility
- Essential officers of any water, electricity or other sector encompassing the provision of electronic communications including print and electronic media
